

FLORIDA HEIKEN CHILDREN'S VISION PROGRAM PROVIDES VISION CARE AT NO COST TO STUDENTS AT THREE ORANGE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

MIAMI – The Florida Heiken Children's Vision Program, a subsidiary of Miami Lighthouse for the Blind and Visually Impaired, will provide comprehensive eye examinations with dilation to students at EVANS High School, JONES High School, and OCPS ACE on December 18th and 19th.

The mission of the Florida Heiken Children's Vision Program is to make sure that all financially disadvantaged school children who fail the State mandated vision screening have access to a comprehensive eye examination including dilation and glasses, if required, to give them the best chance at academic success. These services are offered at no cost to the student and family throughout Florida, either on-site at schools via five mobile eye clinics or by the Heiken Program's network of more than 1,100 participating optometrists.
