Directions to Miami Lighthouse:

From the North: Take I-95 South to the SW 7th Street exit. At the bottom of the ramp, turn right onto SW 7th Street. Proceed to the next traffic light, which is SW 8th Avenue and turn right. Our parking lot is on the right-hand side, about a ½ block down.

From the South: Take US 1 North until it becomes I-95 North. Take the SW 8th Street exit. At the traffic light go straight ahead to the next traffic light, which is SW 7th Street. Turn left. Go to SW 8th Avenue (a traffic light) and turn right. Our parking lot is on the right-hand side, about a ½ block down. Alternate parking on the street or via shuttle service from Bascom Palmer Eye Institute.
